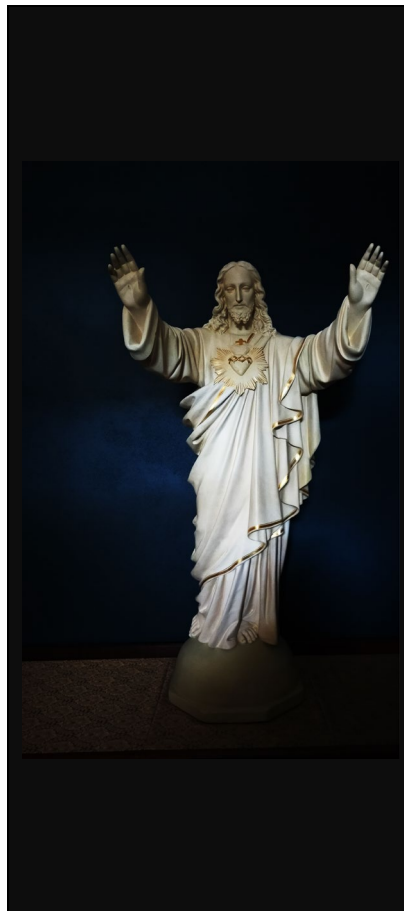

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

**Friday 14 August
6.00pm**

**Saturday 15 August
9.30am**

The Assumption (August 15th) refers to the Blessed Virgin Mary being assumed – body and soul – into heaven at the end of her earthly life. “Assumption” is different than “Ascension” because one is passive (i.e. one is assumed) and the other is active (i.e. one ascends). It is by the power of God Mary was assumed.

The Assumption is a Holy Day of Obligation, which means Catholics are obligated to attend Mass this day. Our parish offers a vigil Mass (which means a Mass held the evening before the feast, because, in keeping with the Jewish roots of Christianity, a holy day begins at sundown) and a Mass during the day on the Assumption. Make it a priority to get to Mass. We gather to show our love and affection for Our Blessed Mother and by doing so we bring glory to her Son.
