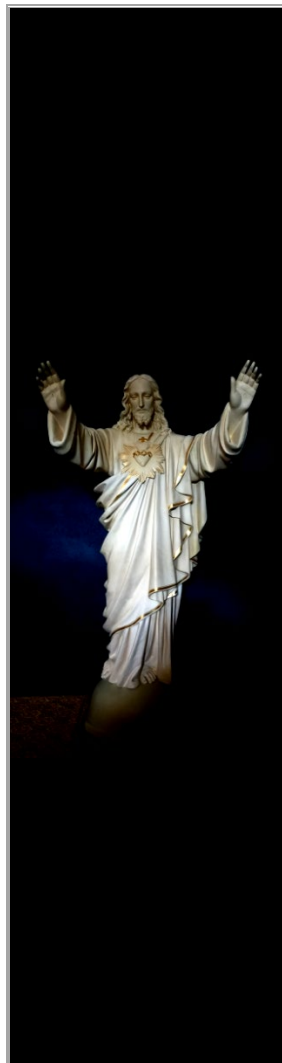

A wonderful day was spent at St Patrick's Cathedral on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> October.

Prayers were offered then a self-guided tour around the seven chapels, including the Chape of the Sacred Heart.

Originally designated to be the organ and choir gallery, the chapel was dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus after the arrival of a Sacred Heart statue from Germany in 1874 and the dedication of the Diocese of Melbourne to the Sacred Heart in 1875.

All then gathered at Fitzroy Gardens for lunch by the fountain.
