Australian bishop appointed to Roman Curia

Pope Leo XIV has appointed Bishop of Broken Bay Anthony Randazzo as the Prefect of the Dicastery for Legislative Texts.

The appointment to the Roman Curia is accompanied by the conferral of the title Archbishop and nomination as the Apostolic Administrator of the Broken Bay diocese. The appointment makes him the most senior Australian at the Vatican.

The Dicastery for Legislative Texts is the Vatican body responsible for interpreting Church laws and ensuring their correct application worldwide.
