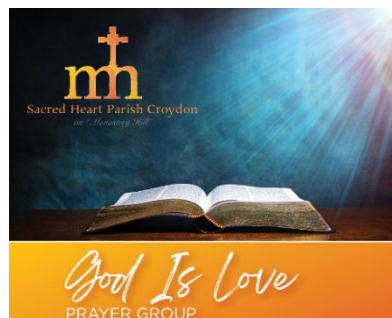
Annual Marriage Anniversaries Mass

Love was in the air at St Patrick's Cathedral last
Sunday 12 July, as more than 250 couples and their
families gathered for the largest celebrations held as
couples gathered to mark anniversaries ranging
from five years to 70 years.

The event was extra special for Joseph and Doris
Gauci, who have been married for 70 years, the
couple hail from the Parish of St Matthew's in
Fawkner North.

During the Mass Archbishop Comensoli expressed
his gratitude to the couples for all their years of
'creative and life-giving witness'. Reflecting on the
gospel (the Parable of the Sower), the Archbishop
described Christian marriage as 'an image of God',
who is 'the sower, the giver of life'.

'By its nature, marriage sows. It sows seeds of
respecting and honouring, of reconciling and
forgiving, of sacrificing and safeguarding, of
friendship and intimacy. We generally give the
umbrella term "love" to sum up this way of marital life.
It is true and good to do so.'
